

Information for Preconference participants delivering a Lightning Talk

For the Lightning Talk session, we split into three smaller breakout groups. You will be allocated to one of these rooms. Please note:

- Your Lightning Talk should only be 2-3-minutes long. It therefore requires that you consider the most important information that you wish to share about your research. In some cases, you will not have completed your research and therefore your lightning talk will speak to where you are up to.
- A timer will be set to ensure that you can keep to time as we will have many Lightning Talks to get through.
- Your Lightning Talk is only delivered verbally (have with you all the notes you need!) and will *not* involve any visual presentation such as a PowerPoint. This is to allow for a smooth and timely transition between these talks.
- Following your Lightning Talk, we will open the floor to any questions or comments from the audience. If you wish, you can use this time to pose a question to the audience about an aspect of your research that you would like some feedback or guidance with, or simply open it up to the audience for questions/comments.
- Question time will also be timed, so that we can move through each Lightning Talk within the time that we have available.

This is a very safe and supportive space, and we are looking forward to learning more about you and your research.
